SPRI Announces Plans to Re-canvass ANSI/SPRI FX-1 2001

Waltham, MA, August 2005 – SPRI, the association representing sheet membrane and component suppliers to the commercial roofing industry announced its plans to reaffirm ANSI/SPRI FX-1 2001 Standard Field Test Procedure for Determining the Withdrawal Resistance of Roofing Fasteners.

This standard, which was first approved in 1996, revised and re-approved in 2001, is used to obtain data used by roofing professionals to calculate the proper density and placement of roofing fasteners used in membrane roofing systems and by roofing installers and inspectors as a quality control test to ensure that sufficient pullout performance is achieved. As required by the American National Standards Institute policy, all National Standards must be re-evaluated every five years. SPRI intends to re-canvass this standard beginning in August 2005.
