### Call to Order

The ED-1 Task Force meeting was called to order at 2:15 p.m. CT by Bob LeClare, Task Force Chair. The SPRI Antitrust Statement was read. \*

### Reports & Updates

The Task Force objective was stated to be to canvass the existing ANSI/SPRI ED-1 Standard as required by the ANSI process. This standard is intended as a tool for those that design, specify, and manufacture roofing materials and edge systems, and SPRI has no current intentions to propose it be included in Code.

The following was recommended:

- The GCp values in ASCE 7-10 and ASCE 7-16 are not the same; therefore, there will need to be two sets of tables for A2 and A3;
- The snow load maps in ASCE 7-10 and ASCE 7-16 appear to be the same, but the map needs to be updated to a cleaner version, so the 2016 map will be used;

\*SPRI complies with antitrust laws and requires participants in its programs to comply with antitrust laws. Discussions which could affect competitive pricing decisions or other competitive factors are forbidden. There may be no discussions of pricing policies or future prices, production capacity, profit margins or other factors that may tend to influence prices. In discussing technical issues, care should be taken to avoid discussing potential or planned competitive activities. Members and participants should be familiar with the SPRI Antitrust Policy and act in conformity with it.



- Table A (Importance Factor) will be deleted, because no active versions of code use it;
- It was suggested and agreed that when referring to field perimeter and corner zones, the ASCE 7 numbers of 1, 2, and 3 be used in lieu of, or in addition to, the terms field, perimeter, and corner; and
- It was suggested that the term “Nailer” or even blocking be eliminated as edge metal can be attached to other materials. We will investigate alternative terms.
